

# Cable-and-Bobble Coffee Press Cozy

## Approximate size

12 inches circumference, 5.5 inches height. (Fits an eight-cup Bodum-brand coffee press)

## Gauge

4 stitches/inch

## Yarn

Rowanspun Aran (discontinued), Colourway #961

## Needles

6mm straight needles, 5mm dpns

## Cable-and-bobble pattern:

Row 1: K4, P6, K5, P6, K2, P2, K2, P6, K5, P6, K4

Row 2: K2, P2, K6, P5, K6, P2, K2, P2, K6, P5, K6, P2, K2

Row 3: See Row 1

Row 4: K2, P2, K6, P2, mb, P2, K6, P2, K2, P2, K6, P2, mb, P2, K6, P2, K2

Row 5: See Row 1

Row 6: See Row 2

Row 7: See Row 1

Row 8: K2, P2, C3F, P5, C3B, P2, K2, P2, C3B, P5, C3F, P2, K2

## Abbreviations

**K:** knit

**P:** purl

**mb:** Make bobble. Knit, purl, knit into one st., turn. P3, turn. K3, turn. P3, turn. Pass second and third sts over first st., knit that stitch through the back loop.

**C3f:** Slip 3 sts onto cable needle, hold in front, K3, K3 sts from cable needle.

**C3b:** Slip 3 sts onto cable needle, hold in back, K3, K3 sts from cable needle.

### **Directions:**

Cast on 48 sts, or however many you need to equal the circumference of your press (to get this number, multiply gauge-per-inch by the circumference you want, in inches) using a long-tail cast-on.



K one row. (This will leave you with 2 rows garter stitch, because the long-tail cast on produces one row of knit stitches)

Work setup row: K2, P2, K6, P5, K6, P2, K2, P2, K6, P5, K6, P2, K2.

Work eight rows of cable-and-bobble pattern. Repeat, until cozy is desired length - about three repeats.

Knit 2 rows even, bind off.

### **Finishing:**

Using double-pointed needles and right side facing, pick up 3 stitches on the vertical (short) side, one inch from the top of the cozy. Work in i-cord for six inches.

Repeat on the same side one inch from the bottom, and on the other side - four six-inch-long ties.

Weave in all ends.
